## POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR EXTRACTIONS

- 1. Bite on gauze for **2 hours**. If bleeding persists, then continue biting on gauze until it stops.
- 2. Avoid the following for the first 24 hours:
  - Smoking
  - Drinking through straws
  - Sucking on gauze
  - Spitting
  - Strenuous Exercise
- 3. Keep fingers and tongue away from socket
- 4. Following dental surgery, it is normal to experience some discomfort. If medications have been prescribed, take as instructed.
- 5. **Swelling and stiffness** are normal after extractions for 48 hours and should not cause alarm.
- **6.** A liquid or soft diet is advisable during the first 24 hours. **Drink lots of fluids.**
- 7. It is normal for saliva to be slightly streaked with blood for about 1-2 days. If abnormal bleeding occurs, call our office.
